Catechism Class Begins Saturday, February 3rd

We will be starting a Catechism Class on Saturday, February 3rd. We will meet on Saturdays at 4:30pm, followed by Vespers. Our first class will be an explanation of what it means to be a catechumen, what the class will entail, and an explanation of the prayers to be prayed to become a catechumen in the Orthodox Church. Typically, the stage of being a catechumen is around one year (maybe more, maybe less) depending on each person's circumstances as guided by the parish priest. We will be reading a book titled, "The Orthodox Faith, Worship, and Life" by Hieromonk Gregorios and published by New Rome Press. The price of the book is \$26.00. If you cannot afford the book, assistance is available.

This class is for **Catechumens Only**. A catechumen is a person who is in the preparation process to enter the Orthodox Church through the sacraments of Holy Baptism and/or Holy Chrismation.
