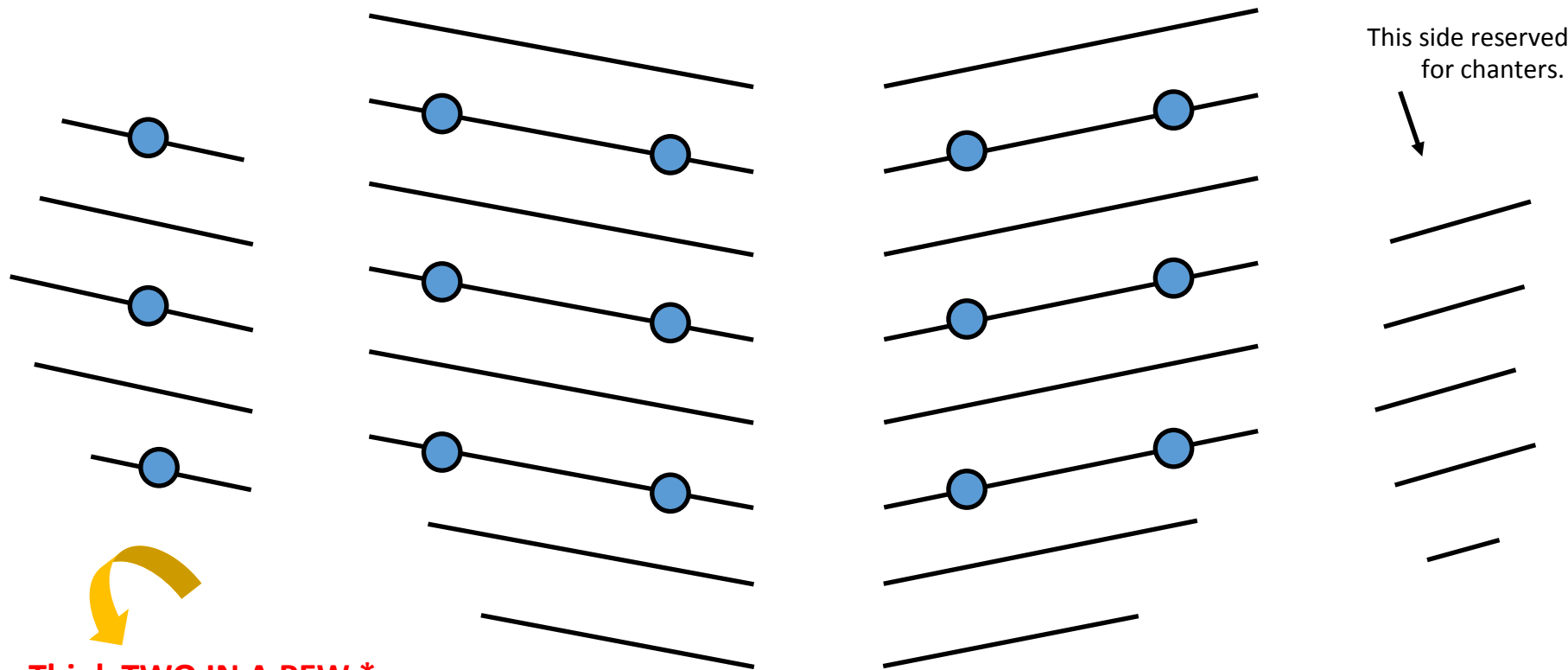
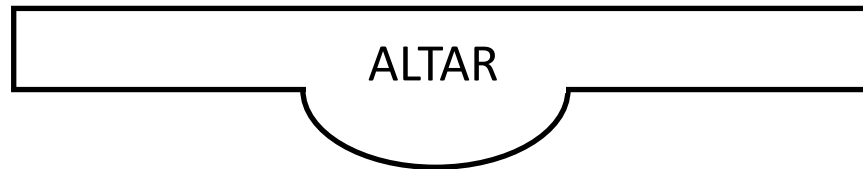


Seating guide for  
Sunday Divine Liturgy on  
May 24 and 31, 2020



**Think TWO IN A PEW \***

**INDIVIDUALS** may sit at any blue-marked space EXCEPT REMEMBER “TWO IN A PEW” so if two people (or a family) are already in that pew, sit elsewhere! Example: If a couple is sitting together at one end, no one else sits in that pew.

**FAMILY MEMBERS LIVING IN THE SAME HOUSEHOLD** may sit close together at or between any blue-marked spaces, as long as no one else is in that pew when they sit down.

**EVERYONE** please sit no closer to the aisle than the blue mark. Also, we are required to “skip a pew” so every other pew remains empty. For us, this means the front-row pews and two back pews of center section remain vacant.

\* The 2-person rule may be exceeded if they are family members living in the same household.

● Five additional seats will be available in the back if needed.
